WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY					

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1. FOREWORD

Information provided pursuant to Art. 13 of European Regulation No. 679/2016 (GDPR)

When you navigate our website or use our services, we collect information and personal data about you. For this reason, in accordance with the provisions of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (hereinafter “GDPR”) and with any implementing legislation, this document (hereinafter “Privacy Policy”) has been published in order to describe to you which kind of personal data we collect, the purposes and methods of processing them, and the security measures we take to protect them.

This Privacy Policy constitutes the disclosure to Data Subjects issued pursuant to the applicable data protection regulations.

You are hereby informed that this Privacy Policy applies to the website consulted, the services, apps and social network accounts (hereinafter the “Services”) and it does not apply to third-party websites that may be referred to via links or banners within the Site.

2. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

Processing operations related to the web services of these Sites are handled only by technical personnel, or by persons authorised to carry out occasional maintenance operations. No personal data are requested from users, as the site does not require membership of services.

3. DATA SOURCE AND PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

3.1. NAVIGATION DATA

The IT systems responsible for the operation of the Services acquire, in the course of their normal operation, some of your personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This information is not collected for the purpose of identifying you, but may lead to your identification if, for instance, it is combined with data held by third parties. This category of data includes the IP address and the domain name of your computer, the URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) notation addresses of the resources requested, the time of the request, the method used to submit the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server and other parameters relating to your operating system. We use this data for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the Services and to check that they are working properly. We delete data collected in this way immediately after processing. The data could be used to ascertain liability in the event of IT crimes committed against the Services.

3.2. INFORMATION FOR SPECIFIC SERVICES

Navigating our Sites does not require the creation of a personal account.

There are no contact forms on the site to request or provide information.

3.3. NATURE OF PROVISION

Providing us with the information referred to in Section 4.1. is mandatory in order to navigate our Sites.

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4. METHODS OF DATA PROCESSING AND STORAGE

We process your personal data with the help of electronic means and always in compliance with the security requirements of the applicable regulations. Our security measures include contractual means with any contractor (e.g. service providers) or agent to ensure the protection of the security and confidentiality of personal data in accordance with the provisions of applicable data protection legislation.

We store personal data for as long as is necessary to fulfil the purpose for which it was collected.

4.1. INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will only be processed by persons previously authorised to process them, i.e. Data Processors. Any third party that is the recipient of your data in the context of this procedure may use it within the limits set out in this Privacy Policy.

4.2. TRANSFER OF DATA ABROAD

Personal data collected through the site will not be transferred outside Italy to third party recipients established within the European Union, nor to third Countries outside the European Union.

5. RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

You may exercise your rights under the GDPR at any time, as follows:

Request for access to your personal data: you have the right to obtain from the Data Controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed and, if so, access them. Access involves the disclosure of certain information, including the purposes of the processing, the categories of personal data processed and the recipients to whom the data are disclosed.

However, there is no right of access that can be exercised absolutely, and the interest of other individuals may limit your right of access. You also have the right to obtain a copy of the personal data being processed. A fee may be charged for additional copies.

Rectification of your personal data: you have the right to obtain the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning you, as well as to obtain the integration of incomplete personal data, including by providing a supplementary declaration.

Erase of your personal data: you have the right to obtain from the Data Controller the deletion of personal data concerning you without undue delay, and the Data Controller has to delete your personal data without undue delay if certain circumstances exist, including the fact that the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or that your consent has been withdrawn.

Limitation of the processing of your personal data: in limited circumstances - including if the accuracy of your data is contested - you have the right to request the limitation of the processing of personal data concerning you.

Data portability: you have the right to receive in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format the personal data concerning you that you have provided to a Data Controller and you have the right to transmit those data to another Data Controller without hindrance from the Data Controller to whom you have provided them where the processing was based on consent and is carried out by automated means.

Objection to processing: you have the right to object to the processing of personal data concerning you at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation.

The right to lodge a complaint with the competent data protection authority remains unaffected.

6. DATA CONTROLLER

Following consultation of this site, data relating to identified or identifiable persons may be processed.

7. DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

The Data Controller is responsible for data protection. It is possible to contact the Data Controller to exercise all the rights provided for in Articles from 15 to 21 of the GDPR: the right of access, rectification, erasure, limitation, portability, objection, as well as to revoke a previously granted consent; in the event of failure to respond to their requests, Data Subjects may lodge a complaint with the data protection authority (pursuant to Art. 13(2)(d) of the GDPR).
